



Dear SPR Families:

Here are some reflections on opening day of summer camp 2020 registration:

First, kudos to our staff who processed over 100 registrations today. In the last decade, we have never processed this many registrations in one week of camp enrollment, let alone in 4 hours.

Thank you to our families for your overwhelming response to our K-8 camp registration. We appreciate your support of our programs and your patience with our format for registering this season.

Our summer camp this year has very limited enrollment. We are fortunate to be in a position to plan a program this summer, but must adhere to all guidelines set forth by the state and CDC in order to do so, which at the moment includes restrictions on group sizes. This morning our summer camp enrollment opened at 9:00am: we can report as of today at 2:00pm, we are sold out of two age groups:

- Pepperell Pathfinders Camp for grades 1&2
- Memorial Memories Camp for grades 3-5

Wait List: if your child is in the grades 1-5 range for the upcoming year, we are now taking wait lists for these age groups. What does this mean? Our camp is set to open in phase 3 of Governor Mills' reopening plan for Maine. There are some possibilities of expansion for these groups, which may come in the form of increased group sizes as permitted, or alternate additional locations for same age groups if there is enough interest. We will know more as we approach the start of camp and trends in our state are analyzed. We will place campers off the wait list in date/time order as spots become available. While we cannot guarantee what the future will hold, we are optimistic that we may be able to offer additional opportunities.
